

2024 HUD Continuum of Care Program Competition Application Process

INTRODUCTION

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) released the FY2024 Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for homeless assistance through HUD's Continuum of Care Program on July 31, 2024.

As the Collaborative Applicant for the AL-508 Continuum of Care, The Southeast Alabama Coalition for the Homeless (SEACH) is accepting applications for new projects that wish to use HUD CoC Program funding for homeless assistance. Projects will compete for available funds. The CoC Ranking & Review Committee will score and rank all projects meeting threshold requirements. HUD will then award funds based on the CoC Application score and project criteria as outlined in the FY2024 NOFO

ELIGIBILITY

New Project applicants must meet CoC program eligibility requirements and have the financial and management capacity and experience to carry out the project, including experience with similar programs and successful administration of CoC program funds or other federal funds. In addition, they must meet all criteria for the specific component type (Permanent Supportive Housing, Rapid Rehousing, etc.) and housing and services proposed that meet the needs of program participants. To apply for a new project, applicants must be a non-profit organization, entity of local government, housing authority, tribe, or tribal entity.

LOCAL APPLICATION

The Local Competition Application is an application developed specifically for the local competition that all project applicants must complete. The application is designed to collect information that mirrors the requirements for the formal HUD e-snaps application but is tailored to be more accessible for applicants and the Rank and Review Committee. The local application includes narrative responses and required attachments which may include things like project budget, organizational documents, and most recent financial statements or audits.

- Only applicants that, after the local competition, are included on the Priority List will submit the formal HUD e-snaps application for funding.
